215/2022 The Minutes of last years Annual Meeting held on 20th May 2021 were agreed and would be signed. There were no matters arising.

Chairman's Report 216/2022 Chairman, Cllr A E Wigley thanked all the Councillors and Clerk for their work over the past 12 months. It was good to have face to face meetings from March 2022, 2 years on from the first lockdown.
